

## RELIGIOSITY AND SOCIAL MEDIA USAGE

**Abstract.** This paper is a work in progress which tries to explore religiosity and social media usage. Indonesia is the largest Muslim country in the world. With more than 200 million people, almost 90% of them are Muslims. In addition, Indonesia is considered to be in the top 5 countries according to the data by Hootsuite, which says the number of active social media users in Indonesia is 191 million by January 2022, within the overall population of 277 million. Referring to the high number of social media users and the largest Muslim country in the world, it would be highly interesting to study the usage of social media in Indonesia and its link to religiosity, especially considering that Indonesian Muslims are known as moderate Muslims. The data was gathered through a quantitative survey using a convenience sampling of Muslim student respondents in Jakarta and its surrounding areas. The questions to be answered are: do people who claim to be more religious tend to use less social media than people who are less religious? The variables used to measure religiosity in this social context include praying five times a day; obligatory fasting in the month of Ramadan; reading the Qur'an; and other worship activities.
